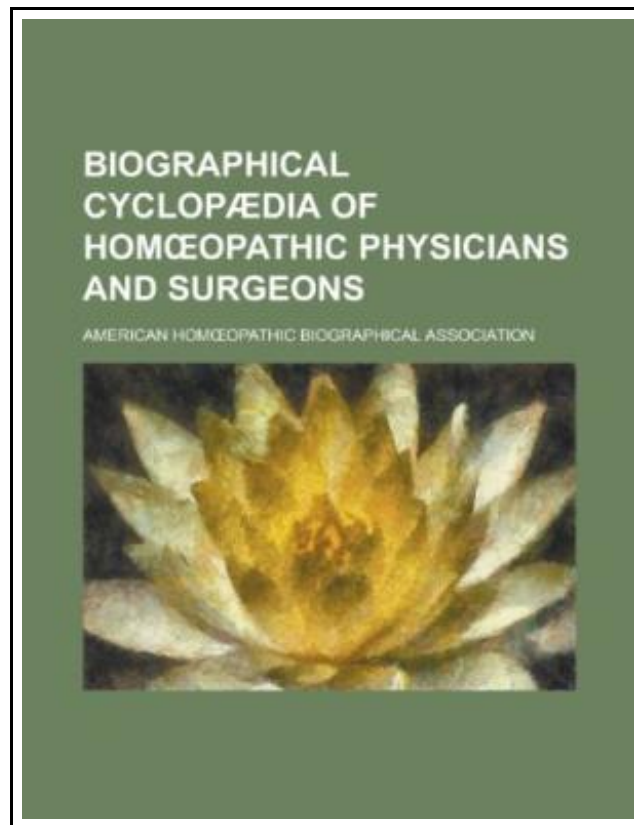

He received his education in the district school, and at the Potsdam and Lawrenceville Academies, located in St. Lawrence county, New York. From Lawrenceville Academy he enlisted in Company F, 106th Regiment, New York Volunteers, and served in that organization until the close of the war. He was severely wounded at Monocacy, Maryland, July 9, 1864, and was mustered out of service in June, 1865, with the rank of First Lieutenant. He began the study of medicine in 1878 at Atlantic, Iowa, with Drs. A. P. and H. K. Macomber, and entered Hahnemann College talents and education; the daughter of James and Sarah (Potter) Stewart, the latter from the line of Potters of which Bishop Potter of New York is also a descendant. His father and mother were married in 1860, and had three children: Aline, born September 7, 1861; Maree, born January 22, 1866, and Joseph. The latter spent his boyhood days in Philadelphia, where he attended the public schools. In 1882 he began the study of medicine with Dr. A. R. Thomas Dean and Professor of Anatomy in the Hahnemann college of Philadelphia, and continued with him for five years. In 1884 he entered the above college and was graduated with high honors in 1887.
